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On Monday, for the first time we hosted our new Bishop, Bishop Paul Martin.

Bishop Paul was welcomed by our head students and Catholic Special Character leaders, and our Kapahaka group performed. Bishop Paul then visited every class and briefly met with staff for morning tea. As a former teacher and Principal Bishop Paul was very comfortable in classes talking to our students.



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You may be aware of the nationwide crisis in recruiting and retaining teachers.

While there are many more children coming into the school system, there are not enough new teachers being trained. Urgent and significant changes are needed to ensure that the teaching profession can attract the people it needs and to ensure class sizes do not start to increase.

Our teaching staff are members of NZEI and legally entitled to attend this meeting. The meetings will allow our teachers to discuss how the Ministry of Education has responded to changes that the union is seeking.

I appreciate that this creates some inconvenience for families. However, I encourage you to support your teachers as they strive to achieve the changes which will safeguard quality education for all children and ensure we make teaching an attractive profession for graduates.

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Term 2 is quickly coming to an end and our mid year break will soon be upon us.



The board has continued with our strategic plan focus and over the next term will be looking specifically at Partnerships as the main focus, and in particular we are looking at how we share student achievement effectively, including looking at ways we report to parents/whanau. We are also looking at the way we communicate with parents/whanau.

We are also currently investigating the purchase of an archgola to provide better shelter and protection for bags in senior classroom blocks. We would like to thank the School Community Group in their assistance on the fundraising for this structure and for their recent assistance to the board and the school in both buying out the lease of the chromebooks and updating our maths equipment.

You will receive an email confirming your interviews. That email will have a code with it that you will need to use if you need to make any changes to the time of the interview later on.

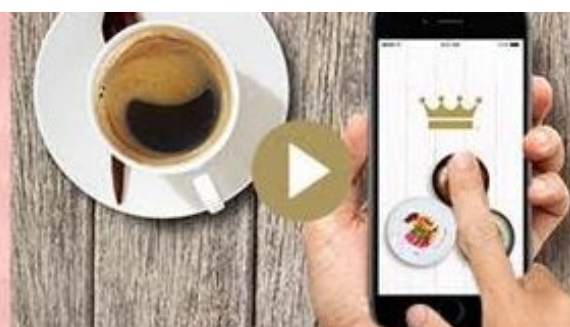
